

No matter where you are in your career, Phi Delta Kappa has a membership category to meet your needs.

Professional and Enhanced Professional — For those who hold at least a bachelor's degree or equivalent and are licensed or credentialed as an educator or employed in an education-related field. Annual dues: \$70 + chapter dues*. *Note: A \$5 application fee will be assessed upon processing.*

International Electronic — A paper-free category of professional membership for those who live outside the U.S., do not have an APO/FPO address, and meet the criteria for professional membership as described above. Annual dues: \$35 + chapter dues*. *Note: A \$2.50 application fee will be assessed upon processing.*

Undergraduate Student — For those enrolled in an accredited education program prior to student teaching. Annual dues: \$35 + 1/2 chapter dues*. *Note: A \$2.50 application fee will be assessed upon processing.*

Associate — For parents, civic leaders, and government officials who want to stay informed about issues in education. Annual dues: \$70 + chapter dues*. *Note: A \$5 application fee will be assessed upon processing.*

Career-changer Associate — For graduate students who are returning to school for the purpose of acquiring their teaching license for the first time in their careers. Annual dues: \$35 + 1/2 chapter dues*. *Note: A \$2.50 application fee will be assessed upon processing.*


Institutional — For institutions, companies, or other agencies that support the mission of PDK. This membership type provides benefits for up to five individuals in a professional community. Annual dues: \$350.
